#### A Word from Pastor Dave

This last week I began our sermon with a picture of a dumpster in New York City with the graffiti, "Alright, God. Now What?" We have all certainly experienced times when it seemed like difficulty came and came and came and came.... Difficulty can be relentless, and it often leaves us with a feeling of "What's next?" We can be despairing, anxious, fearful, and a host of other emotions as we experience the difficulty.

I have two favorite theological terms that you will not find in any theological dictionary or book. The first is "God's got this!" And I truly believe he does. No matter what the situation might be, we live under the rule and reign of a sovereign God who is FOR us and WITH us. He is watching over every detail of our lives. I, for one, am so thankful for this, and I pray that you are too. Let's be sure to give him praise for the many ways that he is WITH us and FOR us: providing for our daily needs, bringing friends into our lives to encourage us, our health or good care when our health is failing, a warm home to live in, a church where Jesus is exalted, etc. As the song so aptly is sung, "Let praise arise!"

Obviously, we often search for meaning to the difficult experiences that come into our lives. "All things work together for good" we might find ourselves saying as we explain the difficulties that we are up against. Sometimes that is helpful, but sometimes it is not. Sometimes it just seems like our difficulties are too big or too painful, and we cry out, "Why me, God?" Well, that takes us to my second favorite theological term, "It's above your pay grade." And it is. There are many times when we simply will not know the "whys" of the difficulties we experience. But we can rest in the fact that the Lord is good...all the time...the Lord is good. And he is.

We have been through quite a lot in the past ten days, and I trust that you are surviving well. Regardless, I want you to be encouraged with these two theological truths. Whatever you might be going through, remember "God's got this!" and if you lack understanding of the reasons he is allowing something into your life, remember "It's above your pay grade!"

May you know the Lord's presence in your life each step of the way. Let's pray for one another and encourage one another to be faithful until Jesus returns.

## Fifty Reasons Jesus Came to Die - Beginning February 11

He also leads us to answer this question - What did God achieve for sinners like us in sending His Son to die? Pick up a **book and daily reflection questions** in the Narthex or the Church Office. We begin reading on **February 11**, fifty days before

Easter. It would be a joy for us to all be reading this book because it would lead to rich discussions and cause us to encourage and exhort one another.
